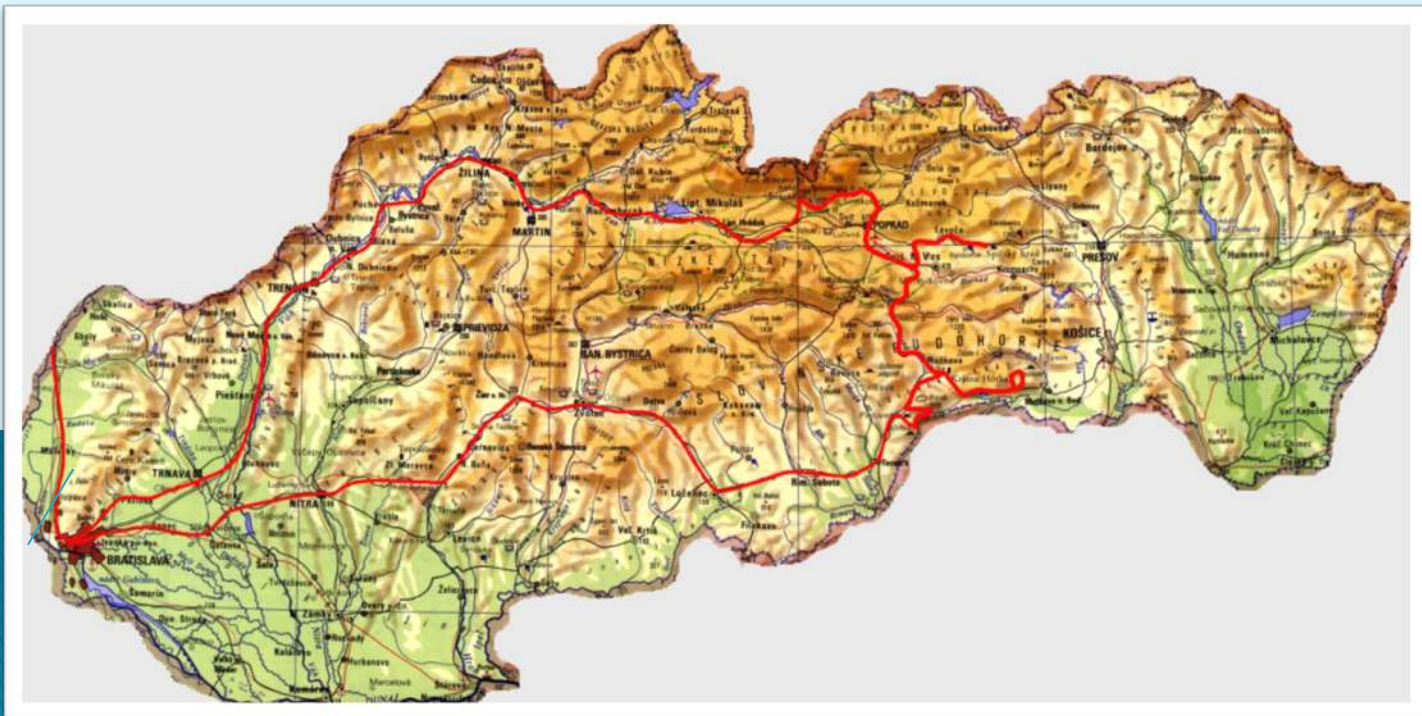




Slovakia – Bratislava

Our school has about 810 pupils. It is the biggest school in our region.

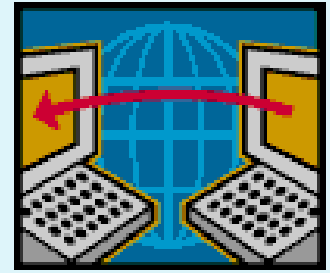

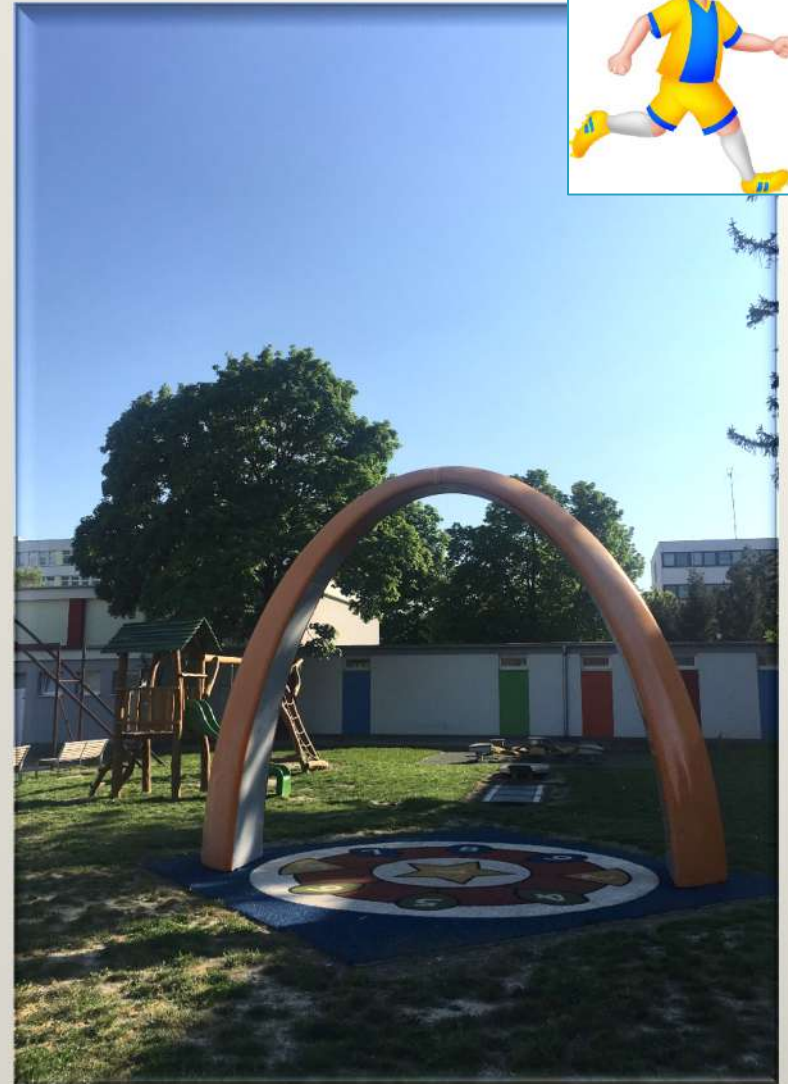

Saint Martin's Cathedral

It is the largest and finest, as well as one of the oldest churches in Bratislava, known especially for previously being the coronation church of the Kingdom of Hungary.



Devín Castle

The ruined and recently renovated Devín Castle is in Devín, on top of a rock where the Morava River, which forms the border between Austria and Slovakia, enters the Danube.

The Primate's Palace is a neoclassical palace in the Old Town of Bratislava the capital of Slovakia. It was built from 1778 to 1781.



Old Town Hall is a complex of buildings from the 14th century in the Old Town of Bratislava. It is the oldest city hall in the country and it is one of the oldest stone buildings still standing in city.
